



Endodontic Post-Treatment Instructions

- It is not uncommon to have mild/moderate soreness for **3-5 days** after the procedure. To manage this, we recommend:
 - Advil [Ibuprofen] - 600mg
 - **Take 600mg every 4-6 hours as needed for pain.**
 - Advil is not recommended if you take blood thinners, are pregnant/nursing, have stomach, gastrointestinal, kidney, or bleeding problems, or have an Ibuprofen allergy.
 - Tylenol [Acetaminophen] - 500mg
 - **Take 500mg every 4-6 hours as needed for pain.**
 - Tylenol is not recommended if you have liver problems or have a Tylenol allergy.
 - Do not take additional Tylenol/Acetaminophen while taking medication such as Vicodin, Percocet, or Norco.
- If a temporary restoration was placed during your treatment, it is not uncommon for it to wear down over time. If you feel the entire temporary restoration is lost, please contact our office.
- We recommend returning to your referring dentist for a final restoration to help seal the tooth promptly after treatment.
